II. Essential documents to be sent with the nomination form:

- (1) **CV of candidate.** This should include details of education, professional work, all publications, honors/awards, policy and community engagement, and memberships in professional bodies.
- (2) **Endorsement.** This should specify why the candidate deserves the award, in two parts:
 - (a) **Academic work:** Spell out key features of the candidate’s research and academic impact in ecological economics (broadly defined to include all environmental social sciences). Be as specific as possible, e.g. which papers or books are especially noteworthy, citations, etc. (1000 words max)
 - (b) **Policy or community engagement:** This should spell out key features of the candidate’s engagement with and impact of work in ecological economics beyond the academe, such as on government policy and/or community practices (1000 words max).
- (3) **List 10 top publications.** For papers, give full details of journal or book in which published and for books, the publisher’s name. Indicate which publications relate to South Asia
- (4) **Copies** of 5 top papers: Provide email links and hard copies
