CALL FOR PAPERS

Contributions are invited for the following sections:

- **RESEARCH PAPER:** address *substantive* research questions, contribute *new* insight and/or provide new findings in the relevant knowledge domain. Must report original research (8000 words).
- **THEMATIC ESSAY/SURVEY:** provide an *exhaustive* account and a *nuanced* critique of the relevant knowledge domains. Does not report original research (4000 words).
- **COMMENTARY:** short pieces on matters of *contemporary relevance* (1500 words).
- **NOTES FROM THE FIELD:** capture *interesting* observations or insights gained from the field, that may not comprise a research paper (1500 words).
- **BOOK REVIEW:** offers a critical *evaluation* of the content, quality, significance of a book (1500 words).
- **REPORT:** synoptic coverage of conferences, workshops, seminars, meetings, symposium and other such, for general dissemination (1000 words).

Submission deadline for EES 4(2) (dated July 2021) is **January 15, 2021**.
